## ORDER

This appeal stems from the purchase of a used car in 2003 which, allegedly, stalled within days of purchase. Plaintiff Yuling Zahn brought suit against defendant Napleton Buick. After a bench trial, judgment was entered in favor of defendant and against plaintiff. Plaintiff appeals, arguing: (1) the trial court lacked jurisdiction to enter judgment; (2) the trial court's order-dismissing particular counts of plaintiff's complaint was void; (3) the trial court erred where it dismissed certain other counts of plaintiff's second amended complaint; (4) the trial court erred where it allowed hearsay evidence at trial; (5) the trial court applied the incorrect legal standard with respect to plaintiff's claims under the "Odometer Act;" and (6) the trial court's verdict in favor of defendant and against plaintiff was against the manifest weight of the evidence. As a supplementary matter, plaintiff filed a motion, which we took with the case, to strike defendant's
